



Rules of the game

The pile of cards is placed in the middle of the table face down.
Each player chooses a counter and stands on the START.
The players roll the dice, the highest roller begins the game.

The first player moves forward according to the number of points on the dice.
Next, the player takes the card from the top of the pile and says the sentence with a verb on it.

Depending on the colour of the circle, the sentence must be as follows:

the **red** circle – a negative sentence
the **blue** circle – a question
the **green** circle – a positive sentence

The player decides whether to use the Present Perfect tense or the Past Simple tense.
The "key" words help to make a decision.

The player who says the sentence in the wrong tense, misses a turn.

When the player stands on the circle with dices – he/she rolls the dice again.

Each player may come across a bad luck or a good luck circle and then he/she moves according to the code on the circle.

The player who first reaches the FINISH – wins the game.

Answers key

1. START
2. **over last 5 years** - Present Perfect e.g. She has learnt a lot over last 5 years.
3. **50 years ago** - Past Simple e.g. Fathers didn't pay by credit card 50 years ago.
4. **yesterday** - Past Simple e.g. Boys saw a football match yesterday.
5. ROLL THE DICE AGAIN!
6. **for** - Present Perfect e.g. Have your sisters read this book for so long?
7. OOPS! MISS ONE TURN!
8. **before yesterday** - Past Simple e.g. Did your aunt work before yesterday?
9. **recently** - Present Perfect e.g. My doctor has flown to Brazil recently.
10. **so far** - Present Perfect e.g. My brother hasn't built a house, so far.
11. **last week** - Past Simple e.g. Did you begin the course last week?
12. **yet** - Present Perfect e.g. My mum hasn't spoken to my teacher, yet.
13. **an hour ago** - Past Simple e.g. His uncle rode a bike an hour ago.
14. **since** - Present Perfect e.g. We haven't made a pizza since last summer.
15. GOOD LUCK! Fly to 31
16. **ever** - Present Perfect e.g. Has your cousin ever run 30 km?
17. **last summer** - Past Simple e.g. Children swam in the ocean last summer.
18. BAD LUCK! Go to 9
19. **just** - Present Perfect e.g. My friend has just woken up.
20. **last night** - Past Simple e.g. The baby didn't sleep well last night.

21. **always** - Present Perfect e.g. People have always sung songs.
22. ROLL THE DICE AGAIN!
23. **never** - Present Perfect e.g. Animals have never learnt English.
24. **last weekend** - Past Simple e.g. I drank delicious juice last weekend.
25. **this week** - Present Perfect e.g. Have you found your ID card this week?
26. **then** - Past Simple e.g. Her cousin didn't give back a book then.
27. **a week ago** - Past Simple e.g. They took a credit a week ago.
28. OOPS! MISS ONE TURN!
29. **last Friday** - Past Simple e.g. Did they go to the disco last Friday?
30. **today** - Present Perfect e.g. My friends haven't met with me today.
31. **last winter** - Past Simple e.g. His family fed birds last winter.
32. **two weeks ago** - Past Simple e.g. Did he win the competition two weeks ago?
33. BAD LUCK! Go to START
34. **already** - Present Perfect e.g. I have already begun my training course.
35. **in 2010** - Past Simple e.g. Their idol didn't sing this song in 2010.
36. **yesterday morning** - Past Simple e.g. Did you come here yesterday morning?
37. **lately** - Present Perfect e.g. Has your pet eaten a meal lately?

39. **last holiday** - Past Simple e.g. My parents didn't fight last holiday.
